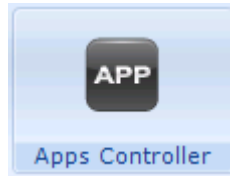




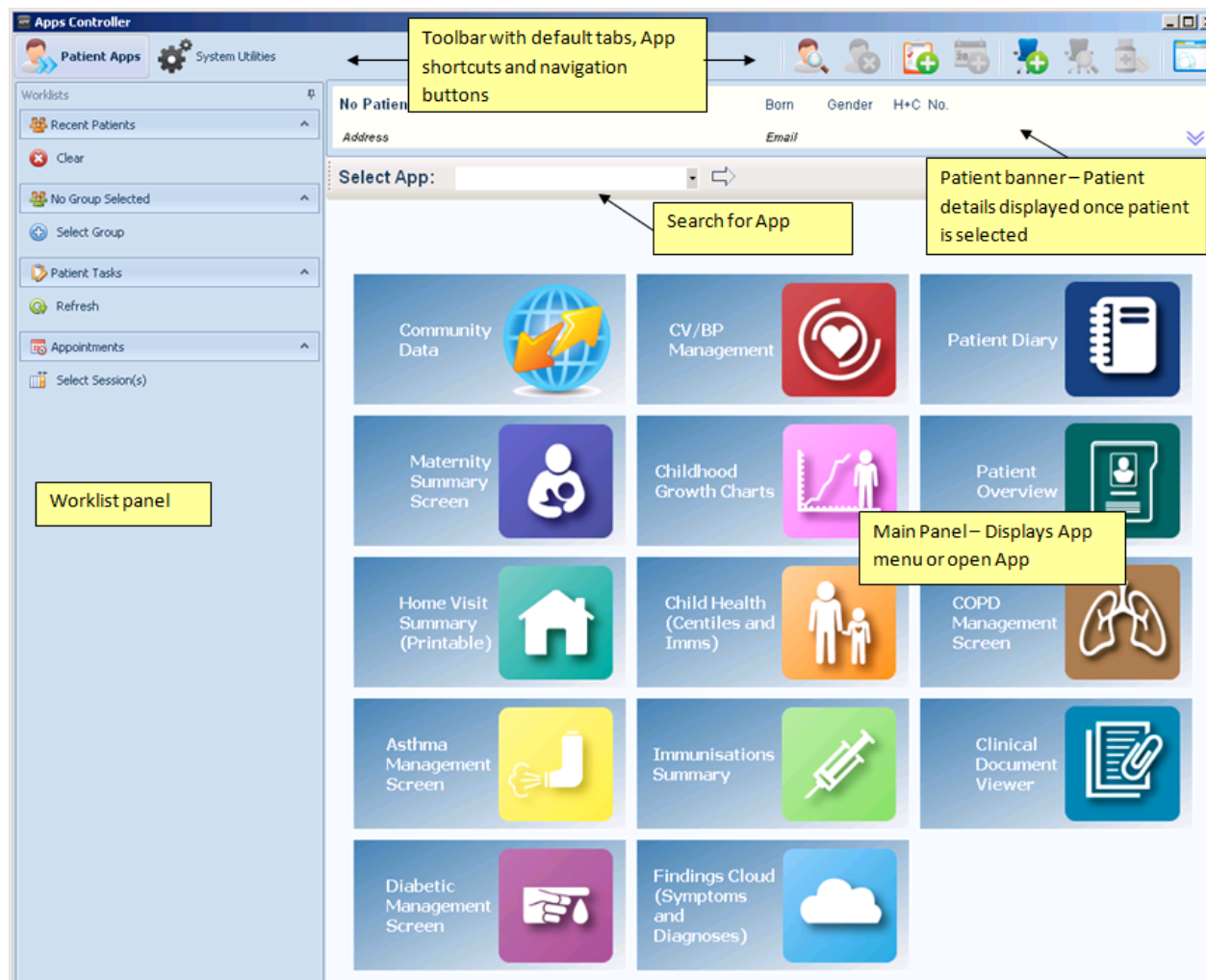
An Overview of Apps Controller

The Apps Controller module is designed to provide views and functions specifically tailored to simplify reception, clinical and system maintenance tasks.

Below is a summary of how to use Apps Controller. For more detailed information, please refer to the Apps Controller on-screen help.



To access Apps Controller, select [Apps Controller](#) Apps Controller from the Vision front screen:













Apps Controller



The Apps Controller screen consists of the following sections:

- **Toolbar** - Displays available tabs and navigation buttons and can be configured to display your preferred apps.

The toolbar contains the following navigation buttons, irrespective of the tab/app displayed:

-  **Patient Apps**, apps that relate to patients. See the individual Patient Apps Quick Reference Guides
-  **System Utilities**, administrative apps with no specific patient context. See the individual System Utilities Apps Quick Reference Guides.
-  **(F3) Select Patient** - Opens the patient select screen and sets the patient context for any app that is opened.
-  **(Shift+F3) Deselect patient** - Deselects the current patient and closes any Apps displaying data for that patient. Intended for use in sensitive areas.
-  **(F2) Add new task** - Opens the Daybook 'Add Task' screen. If a patient is currently selected, the task will be for that patient.
-  **(F6) Make Appointment** - Opens the Make Appointment screen for the current patient.
-  **(F10) Open Patient Record** - Opens an instance of Consultation Manager. Currently selected patient will be selected automatically.
-  **(Shift+F10) Open Patient Record (Read-only)** - Opens Consultation Manager for the currently selected patient but the record is display only.
-  **(F9) Open Therapy Record** - Opens Consultation Manager - Therapy tab for the currently selected patient.
-  **Configuration** - Opens the Menu Configuration screen where you can configure which tabs are displayed on the toolbar.

- **Patient Banner** - Displayed when a patient is selected and is the same standard patient banner used when accessing Vision Apps from Consultation Manager. It displays the following patient demographic information:

- **Name**

- **Born** - Date of birth (age)

- **Gender**

- **NHS/CHI/H+C No**

- **Address**

- **Phone** - Displays Home telephone number if recorded

- **Language Spoken** - Displayed next to Phone if recorded

Click anywhere in the banner to expand and show more detail. The expanded banner shows the above details plus:

- **Address** - In full

- **All phone numbers** - If recorded

- **Email** - If recorded

- **Select App** - Allows you to search for an app by name or keyword.
- **Main Panel** - Displays either patient apps or system utility apps depending on your selection from the toolbar.



Worklist Panel

The **Worklists** panel allows you to navigate a set of patient lists, enabling you to quickly and efficiently process a group of patients within an App:

Recent Patient – A list of patients you have viewed during this Apps Controller session.

Working Group – To select an existing Patient Group. Once a group is selected the group name is displayed.

Patients With Outstanding Tasks – Displays a list of patients with outstanding tasks allocated to the logged on user.

Appointments – Displays patients with an appointment within a selected session

Worklists Panel

-  **Recent Patients** - A list of patients selected within this session the selected patient (if there is one) does not appear on this list. Clicking a patient in the list selects the patient. You can remove all patients from the list by selecting  **Clear**.
-  **Working Group** - On clicking  **Select Group** **Select Group**, a group selection dialog appears listing all patient groups. Once you have selected a group, the **Working Group** section lists all group members. Click to select a patient from a group.
-  **Patients With Outstanding Tasks** **Patient Tasks** - This displays a list of patients with outstanding Daybook tasks allocated to you. It does not display individual tasks, meaning that if a patient has more than one outstanding task, they will only be displayed once irrespective of the number of outstanding tasks they have.
- Patients with overdue tasks are displayed in **red** and are ordered by name but can be sorted by due date and priority when there is more than one patient in the list.
- Click **Order by due date** to list by due date. Click **Order by Priority** to order by priority. Click **Order by Patient** to order alphabetically by patient surname. Clicking on a patient in the list selects the patient.
-  **Appointments** - Click the **Select Session(s)**  button to choose from a list of appointment sessions. Patients with booked slots in that session are displayed - if you click on an item in the list, the associated patient is selected.

Once a patient is selected from one of the lists, the active app is refreshed for the newly selected patient.
